APPLICATION FOR WCVD6 SCHOLARSHIP

The World Congress of Veterinary Dermatology Association (WCVDA) is offering funding to encourage delegates from dermatologically underdeveloped countries*, and particularly younger members of our profession, to attend WCVD6. Since one of the missions of WCVDA is to promote development of veterinary dermatology worldwide, it is hoped that the selected delegates will be able to take advantage of what is learned at the congress to advance veterinary dermatology in their geographic region.

The scholarship consists of a free full registration to WCVD6. Delegates receiving a registration scholarship should be responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses.

The Selection Criteria for successful candidates are:

1. Be normally resident in a dermatologically underdeveloped country*;
2. Show evidence of a longstanding interest and commitment to veterinary dermatology;
3. Have adequate knowledge of the English language to take full advantage of the opportunities;
4. Forward one letter of recommendation, which can be in electronic form, to include a statement of financial need; and
5. Hold a veterinary qualification.

Selection Procedure:

A selection Committee will be appointed to select from the applicant pool, and the Committee may award up to 20 scholarships.
